### **W.I.N. global leadership forum, Sitges - Spain 18-20 September 2008**

Switzerland, February 4

W.I.N. has chosen Spain as the host nation for the 2008 global leadership forum. The ninth largest global economy, Spain has been one of the fast growing economies in the European Union. The country is putting women on the agenda and recently added new legislation to require companies with more than 250 employees to make a goal for their company boards to be made up of at least 40% women within eight years.

W.I.N.'s global leadership forum is designed by women and focuses on how to lead, act and be authentic by applying skills, knowledge, intuition and empathy and looks at how to run companies, institutions and organizations within the new balanced paradigm.

W.I.N. 2008 will bring together an impressive network of leaders; outstanding executives, entrepreneurs, independent professionals, consultants, representatives of international organizations or government bodies, academics and artists from around the globe.

The W.I.N. forum provides the visions, environment, strategies, skills and network that are crucial to reach for success. *Driving change, Articulating and implementing visions, Developing strategies and skills for action, Doing it all and doing it right, Growing the company and growing as individuals* are the main topics that will be discussed and interacted in eight panel sessions and close to fifty workshops.

In 2007 the W.I.N. forum was held in Oslo, Norway, and attracted more than 700 women from 70 countries. Of these 58% were corporate executives, 27% small business owners and entrepreneurs, 8% professionals - doctors, lawyers, academics, artists, journalists and 7% politicians, international servants, NGOs. W.I.N. is an independent European mission driven organization with a global impact. It is run by a team of professionals and supported by a large group of volunteers all inspired by the well-being and progress of our global society.
